

Privacy Policy and Terms of Use Agreement

This Privacy Policy ("Policy") applies to www.nabhiministries.org, and Nabhi Christian Ministries ("Organization") and governs data collection and usage.For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to the Organization include www.nabhiministries.org. The Organization's website is a News and Information site. By using the Organization website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

In order to better provide you with products and services offered, the Organization may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

-First and last name -Mailing address -Email address -Phone number

If you purchase the Organization's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction.

The Organization may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your:

-Age -Gender

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services. These may include: (a) registering for an account; (b) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by us orone of our partners; (c) signing up for special offers from selected third parties; (d) sending us an email message; (e) submitting your credit card or other payment information when ordering and purchasing products and services. To wit, we will use your information for, but not limited to, communicating withyou in relation to services and/or products you have requested from us. We also may gather additional personal ornon-personal information in the future.

Use of your Personal Information

The Company collects and uses your personal information in the following ways:

- -to operate and deliver the services you have requested
- -to provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us
- -to provide you with notices about your account

-to carry out the 's obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered
-to notify you about changes to our www.nabhiministries.org or any products or services we
-in any other way we may describe when you provide the information
-for any other purpose with your consent.

The Organization may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from the Organization and its affiliates.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

The Organization does not sell, rent, or lease its customer lists to third parties.

The Organization may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to the Organization, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

The Organization may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on the Organization or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of the Organization; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of the Organization, or the public.

Automatically Collected Information

The Organization may automatically collect information about your computer hardware and software. This information can include your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding the use of the Organization's website.

Use of Cookies

The Organization's website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize the Organization's pages, or register with Organization's site or services, a cookie helps the Organization to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Organization's features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. SSL Protocol

We strive to take appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to or alteration of your personal information. Unfortunately, no data information over the Internet or any wireless network can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect your personal information, you acknowledge that: (a) there are security and privacy limitations inherent to the Internet that are beyond our control; and (b) the security, integrity, and privacy of any and all information and data exchanged between you and us through this site cannot be guaranteed.

Right to Deletion

Subject to certain exceptions set out below, on receipt of a verifiable request from you, we will:

-Delete your personal information from our records; and -Direct any service providers to delete your personal information from their records.

-Complete the transaction for which the personal information was collected, fulfill the contract terms provide goods or service you requested take actions reasonably anticipated on our ongoing relationship with you, or otherwise perform our contract with you;

-Detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity;

- -Debug to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality;
- -Exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise his or her right;

-Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act;

-Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public;

-Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with us;

-Comply with an existing legal obligation; or

-Otherwise use your personal information, internally, in a lawful manner that is compatible with the context in which you provided the information.

Termination/Access Restriction
